In the fifth chapter of Luke's Gospel we read that Simon, Andrew, James and John were cleaning their nets after fishing -- a hard night with nothing to show. Jesus steps into Simon's boat and asks him to put out a short distance from shore. The crowds gather along the shore, while Simon and Andrew have a front row seat. Jesus then tells Simon to put out into deep water and lower his nets for a catch. Simon knows that this is a crazy idea -- and from a carpenter no less! Tired, invited to a worthless effort, Simon is shocked by the results of trusting the invitation -- more fish than can fit into two boats.

Everyone is invited to the four 7:00 pm events, October 23rd to 26th. First, a concert on Sunday. Mission talks follow Monday and Tuesday. The mission concludes with Mass and talks on Wednesday.
