Dear Parishioners,

Starting Monday, September 19th, we will switch the entrance and exit drives at St. Luke's. Three "ENTER" signs will be at the north drive, and three "EXIT" signs will be at the south drive. The south drive gives a much better view of traffic on Hwy 86 and is a much safer exit from our property. Many believe the north drive much easier to find when approaching St. Luke's -- and it will be very easy to find at night when our new street light is installed!

Parents dropping children off for religious ed will appreciate this change as classes begin September 21st. As you drive in, the building will be on the right side where most passengers sit -- a much safer arrangement.

While most St. Luke parishioners are accustomed to finding the site even at night, most Holy Cross parishioners tell me they have great difficulty at night. I hope these changes will help Holy Cross parishioners to attend the parish mission -- October 23-26.
