Marriage: Those contemplating marriage should contact the office at least EIGHT months prior to the wedding date to schedule an appointment with the Priest.

Anointing of the sick: Please call the parish office to request hospital visits or individual anointing, when someone is seriously ill or having surgery.

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults): Individuals interested in becoming members of the Catholic Community must participate in the process of Christian Initiation. For more information, please call the parish office.

Welcome back to all who have traveled for the holidays. Be sure to pick up a copy of "Resisting Happiness". We have also a few copies of "Rediscovering Jesus" for anyone interested.

The Feast of the Epiphany is a customary day for the Church to announce the special feasts for the upcoming year. I ask leaders for all parish organizations to resolve meeting conflicts.

Other than Sundays, we have 4 obligatory Holy Days: Assumption, Tuesday, August 15; All Saints' Day, Wednesday, November 1; Immaculate Conception, Friday, December 8; and Christmas, Monday, December 25.

Holy Thursday is April 13 with Mass at 7:00 pm, at Holy Cross. Good Friday is April 14 with the Passion Service at 3:00 pm, at Holy Cross. Holy Saturday is April 15 and the only Mass is at 9:00 pm, at St. Luke.

The Feast of the Holy Cross is Thursday, September 14. The Feast of St. Luke is Wednesday, October 18. We will set dates for parish parties once we know local school schedules.
