On a quite different topic, you may have heard that as soon as Pope Francis started serving as Pope, he announced a reform of the curia. Several women at Holy Cross asked me if they could re-start a women's group — and I met with 12 on Saturday morning. I suggested that they follow a "sodality" model, with members praying daily for the intercession of their patron saint. They chose St. Helena for their patron, since she found the True Cross in Jerusalem. Other topics discussed included – learning more about St. Helena, how they could serve the church, and their performance of corporal and spiritual works of mercy.

All women of Holy Cross are invited to join the "Women of St. Helena" at their next meeting on Saturday, April 1, at 9:00 AM in the church hall to further discuss objectives, goals, and activities for the group. Please keep the women in your prayers as they continue to serve God and the church.
