Dear Parishioners,

At long last the severe and deadly flu season seems to have come to an end in the upstate, though it persists in coastal counties of SC. Also, it has been a very bad year for what DHEC describes as “ILI”, “Influenza Like Illness”. So, we will be including again the invitation to exchange the sign of peace at Mass. If you are ever feeling sick, or prefer to be cautious, you are free to simply keep your hands folded and say “Peace be with you” to the people next to you.

In the United States, the suggested sign of peace is a handshake. It is not unusual among some groups or families adopt a more intimate sign. I ask you to consider what you are saying with a different gesture for different individuals at Church? Do you wish some more or different peace than you wish others? We are about to be invited to union with Jesus through His flesh — is this the right time to make a distinction between the people to our left and our right, front and back?
