Saturday at St. Luke, several of our young parishioners will be receiving the Eucharist for the first time. In preparation for this, they received the sacrament of reconciliation for the first time. Parents — be faithful in encouraging your children to make confession a regular part of their Christian life. Put it on your calendar, make it a family event. For a year, try coming to confession at least every 3 months. See what a difference it will make! If you haven't been to confession for a long time — don't worry, but don't let the time get even longer....

Please come to St. Luke this Tuesday evening, May 15th, for the Confirmation Mass at 7:00 PM. Bishop Guglielmone makes great sacrifices to be here personally — he could quite easily delegate this responsibility to priests who live nearer to the parishes. Let's show up and demonstrate to him that we appreciate his presence!

Friday evening, our bishop will ordain Jimmy Touzeau and Francisco Oñate-Vargis at 6:00 PM at St. Mary's in Greenville. It is a rare blessing to have an ordination so close — take advantage of the opportunity if you can!

Since Jimmy is a parishioner of Holy Cross, and has helped out at St. Luke as well over many years, please come and greet him at Holy Cross after the Saturday and Sunday Mass, or at St. Luke after the Sunday morning Mass. This is a week full of celebrations for our parish!

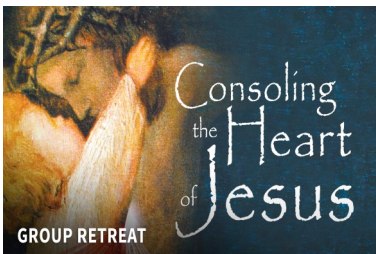

Consoling the Heart of Jesus
Retreat meets Sunday Mornings at 9:30 AM in the Church Hall.
In Consoling the Heart of Jesus, we will learn about God's infinite mercy and how we can give him joy, consoling his heart, by accepting his love and trusting in him completely. We'll discover how suffering can actually help us grow spiritually closer to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

The facilities of Holy Cross are available to all ACTIVE parishioners. This includes the use of the church for Baptism, Weddings & other Sacramental events. Active Membership is determined as follows:

1. Registered in the parish for 6 months.
2. Faithful attendance at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days.
3. Financial support of the church according to your means.

Marriage: Those contemplating marriage should contact the office at least EIGHT months prior to the wedding date to schedule an appointment with the Priest.

Baptism: Parents must attend a training class prior to having a child baptized. Please call the parish office to schedule the training.
