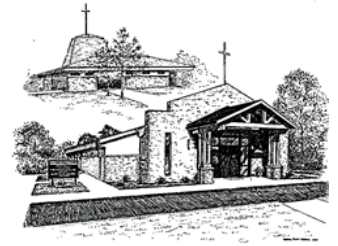

Dear Parishioners,

Today ends the Easter Season proper. There are, however, five feasts that follow. The first is Monday after Pentecost, and it is new this year! So, on Monday we celebrate the feast of Mary, Mother of the Church. Mary gathered the Apostles together in the upper room, and was with them when the Holy Spirit came to them at Pentecost. The next two Sundays celebrate the “Most Holy Trinity” and the “Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ”. The following Friday is the feast of the “Most Sacred Heart of Jesus”, followed immediately by the “Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary”.

On June 3rd, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, we will end the Sunday Masses at both St. Luke and Holy Cross with a special blessing by the Eucharist and a time of Adoration. I ask all groups active at our churches to encourage members to pray together during this special time of adoration.

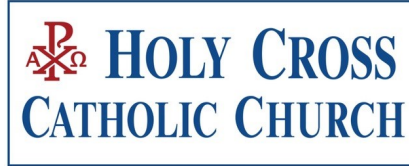

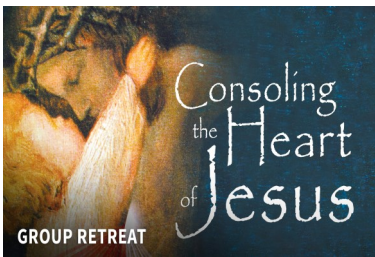

The facilities of Holy Cross are available to all ACTIVE parishioners. This includes the use of the church for Baptism, Weddings & other Sacramental events. Active Membership is determined as follows:

1. Registered in the parish for 6 months.
2. Faithful attendance at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days.
3. Financial support of the church according to your means.

Marriage: Those contemplating marriage should contact the office at least EIGHT months prior to the wedding date to schedule an appointment with the Priest.

Baptism: Parents must attend a training class prior to having a child baptized. Please call the parish office to schedule
