Marriage: Those contemplating marriage should contact the office at least EIGHT months prior to the wedding date to schedule an appointment with the Priest.

Anointing of the sick: Please call the parish office to request hospital visits or individual anointing, when someone is seriously ill or having surgery.

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults): Individuals interested in becoming members of the Catholic Community must participate in the process of Christian Initiation. For more information, please call the parish office.

Dear Parishioners,

They did not start big -- they were so small that Paul worked as a tent maker to support himself. Holy Cross and St. Luke's are each big compared to St. Paul's congregations at their start. We priests today dedicate all of our time to serving the Church. We cannot get jobs making tents to support ourselves. We rely on your support of the Church to provide for all the needs of the Church.
