Dear Parishioners,

In Fatima 100 years ago, in 1917 from May 13 to October 13, Mary appeared six times to young siblings Jacinto & Maria, and their 10 year old cousin Lucia. They were told to pray the rosary for the conversion of sinners, for the souls in purgatory, and for the conversion of Russia. Mary asked them to ask the pope to consecrate Russia to Mary and her Immaculate Heart. On March 25, 1984, Pope St. John Paul II, in union with many Catholic bishops and even five Russian Orthodox Patriarchs, consecrated Russia and all needy individuals and nations to the Immaculate Heart. Atheism in Russia had set in very deeply — and change does not come quickly. The Berlin wall fell in 1989. Last week, the cathedral that was converted to a “Museum of Atheism” under the Communist regime will be restored to use as a cathedral. This year, at the request of a Russian Orthodox Church diocese and local health officials, abortions are banned for one day in the Russian city of Yaroslavl to commemorate the “massacre of the innocents” in Bethlehem around the time of Jesus’ birth.

For many years, America has been accepting a culture of divorce and death. On January 22, 1973 the Supreme Court mandated legal abortion in all states — this marked a tragic fall. Prayer is a powerful tool to change many hearts. Many hearts change slowly, so we need to persevere in prayer.
