Dear Parishioners,

Some schools are on “Spring Break” during Holy Week, and many parishioners will be traveling. I pray for your safe travel.

I hope that you will be able to take part in the services of Holy Week, even if you are traveling. The Easter Vigil is the greatest of these services, and it must begin after dark; no other Mass is permitted. Our Easter Vigil begins at 9:00 pm at St. Luke. There is a special Mass of the Lord’s Supper on Holy Thursday usually in the evening -- at 7:00 pm at Holy Cross.

The Good Friday “Celebration of the Lord’s Passion” at Holy Cross is at the traditional time, 3:00 pm -- the hour of our Lord’s death. On this day we read the passion from the Gospel of St. John, pray solemn intercessions, venerate the cross, and have the opportunity to receive the Eucharist consecrated on Holy Thursday. The solemn intercessions are for the Church, the Pope, the faithful, the catechumens, unity among Christians, the Jewish people, those who do not believe in Christ, those who do not believe in God, those in public office, and those in tribulation. Bishop Guglielmone asks us to pray on Good Friday for peace in our world, our nation, our families, and for the respect and full protection of children in the womb.
