Dear Parishioners,

May 13 marks the one hundredth anniversary of Mary's first appearance at Fatima. We will review Mary's messages over the year. This is only fitting since she appeared six times to Lucia, Jacinta, and Francisco.

We should also remember that the angel of peace appeared to the children to prepare them to meet Mary.

In the spring of 1916, the angel taught them to pray "My God, I believe, I adore, I hope and I love you! I beg pardon for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope and do not love You.

He returned in the fall of 1916 and taught them the Angel's Prayer: O Most holy Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, I adore You profoundly. I offer You the most precious Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ, present in all the tabernacles of the world, and reparation for the outrages, sacrileges, and indifference by which He is offended. By the infinite merits of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg the conversion of poor sinners.

We need to ask ourselves: have we offended God with outrages, sacrilege, or indifference? Let us repent and believe hope adore and love God!
