I am excited about the August 19th day of reflection at Holy Cross for the women of Holy Cross and St. Luke: "Mary at the Cross -- Yesterday and Today." Several disciples stayed with Mary at the foot of the cross while Jesus died for us. The Cross has protected Christians in many ways over the years, and you will hear of some surprising miracles. Meditations on the Cross are the basis for the "Stations of the Cross", the "Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary", and many other devotions.

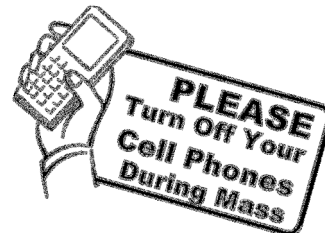
