The Diocese of Charleston was established in 1820; 2020 is our 200th anniversary! We are one of the 6 oldest dioceses in the USA. Bishop Guglielmone hopes to strengthen the diocese with a capital campaign to prepare us for a dynamic future. He invited Catholics throughout the diocese to participate in a survey on values, concerns, hopes and expectations. We passed this invitation on to parishioners in the bulletin of June 6th. Survey results helped our bishop form tentative goals for the campaign. These cover four pages, and are posted on the bulletin board in the education wing.

As near as I can tell, several key decisions remain to be made related to this campaign. Please join me in praying for Bishop Guglielmone and his advisors as they endeavor to strengthen the Church in South Carolina.
